#### **Contributions for the Sanctuary**

*25 The Lord said to Moses, <sup>2</sup> “Speak to the people of Israel, that they take for me a contribution. From every man whose heart moves him you shall receive the contribution for me. <sup>3</sup> And this is the contribution that you shall receive from them: gold, silver, and bronze, <sup>4</sup> blue and purple and scarlet yarns and fine twined linen, goats’ hair, <sup>5</sup> tanned rams’ skins, goatskins, acacia wood, <sup>6</sup> oil for the lamps, spices for the anointing oil and for the fragrant incense, <sup>7</sup> onyx stones, and stones for setting, for the ephod and for the breastpiece.*

### **2. God wants to dwell with His people (Ex 25:8).**

*<sup>8</sup> And let them make me a sanctuary, that I may dwell in their midst.*

### **3. God gave deliberate instructions on the tabernacle for a reason (Ex 25:9).**

*<sup>9</sup> Exactly as I show you concerning the pattern of the tabernacle, and of all its furniture, so you shall make it.*
