**Title:** “The LORD Provides”

**Text:** Exodus 15:22–17:7

**Series:** *Exodus: God Sovereignly Saves His People*

**i. The Pattern: Grumbling met with Undeserved Grace (Exodus 15:22-27)**

A. Without drinkable water, the Israelites grumble, but in grace, God makes the water sweet (15:22–25)

B. The LORD explains the Lesson – the LORD is Your Healer: Trust and Obey (15:25b–27)

**I. The Bread = The LORD Provides Every Day (Exodus 16)**

A. Again, the people grumble, again the people wish to return to Egypt (16:1–3)

B. Again, the LORD provides totally by grace—again to see if they will trust and obey (16:4–8)

**The Details of Daily Bread:**

(1) “From Heaven, for You” (v. 4a) = By Grace

(2) “You must go out and gather” (v. 4b) = Through Faith

(3) “You shall see the glory of the LORD” (v. 7a) = By and To the Glory of God Alone

C. The LORD Provides Everyday (16:9–18) → “So you will know that I AM the LORD your God” (16:12)

D. Some refuse to trust God with tomorrow (16:19–30)

E. “Manna” = Bread from Heaven (16:31–36)

## **II. The Rock = The LORD Provides Everything (Exodus 17)**

A. Again, the people grumble, again the people wish to return to Egypt (17:1–3)

B. Again, the LORD provides totally by grace—again to see if they will trust and obey (16:4–7)
