Title: “Jesus, The Bread of Life”
Text: John 6:1–15, 35–40
Series: *The Gospel of John*

ACT 1: Jesus’ Incredible (Additional) Miracle (John 6:16–21)

1. After miraculously feeding the Crowd of thousands, Jesus walks on water (John 6:16–21).

ACT 2: The Crowd’s Incredible (Additional) Rejection (John 6:41–71)

(1) The Crowd grumbles against Jesus because Jesus said He came down from Heaven (John 6:41–42).

(2) Jesus answers the Crowd:

A. He is the Son from Heaven with the Father and those the Father draws come to Him (John 6:43–46).

B. Jesus is the Bread of Eternal Life (John 6:47–51).

(3) Jesus tells the Crowd “unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink His blood, you have no life in you” (John 6:52–59).

(4) “Many of His Disciples” from the Crowd “turned back and no longer walked with Him” (John 6:60–66).

(5) True Disciples stay with Jesus because, “Lord, to whom shall we go? You have the words of eternal life” (John 6:67–71)

Principles in the Crowd's Pattern of Rejection

#1. People who are only interested in earthly concerns (and personal comfort) reject Jesus.

#2. People cannot come to Jesus who will not come to Jesus.

#3. People who come to Jesus for eternal life recognize they are dead without Him.

#4. People who come to Jesus are distinguished from the Crowd.
