Title: "Seeing God's Glory" **Text:** Exodus 33–34

Series: Exodus: God Sovereignly Saves His People

- (1) Moses requests to see the LORD's glory (Ex 33:18).
- (2) The LORD agrees to reveal His goodness, tied to His Name (Ex 33:19)

Because the LORD is infinitely good:

- A) The LORD sovereignly chooses to be gracious and merciful as He wills $(v.\ 19b)$
- B) The LORD shields Moses from death, while allowing a glimpse of His glory (vv. 20–22)
- C) The LORD chooses to show Moses His glory from the back perspective (v. 23)
- (3) The LORD reveals His Name to Moses further (Ex 34:1–9)
 - A) The LORD is full of love, mercy, grace, and faithfulness (v. 6)
 - B) The LORD is full of justice, righteousness, and truth (v. 7)
